

Oreck Discover Upright : Power Cord Replacement per CPSC Recall

This notice is to provide a notification and resolution for power cord prongs detaching from the power cord plug per the CPSC recall for Oreck Discover.

Tools Needed:

Phillips Head Screwdriver, Wire Cutter, Wire Stripper

Parts Needed:

430001800 : UK30500 Power Cord Kit









REPLACEMENT INSTRUCTIONS:

Make sure the vacuum is NOT connected to power before beginning this repair

STEP 1

Remove (1) Phillips screw holding the cord dump. Remove (4) Phillips screws in upper handle including the screw behind the cord dump.

Remove handle cover and handle tube from handle. Do not lose metal bushings on top cover screw bosses.



STEP 3

Install new power cord into handle.

Strip wires to desired length.

Connect white-white and black-black wires using wire nuts. Push strain relief firmly into place using alignment ribs.



STEP 2

Locate white and black power cord wires. Cut off white wires near the crimp. Cut off black wire from power cord near the exit. Do not cut green, yellow, black wire from nozzle cord. Remove old power cord from handle.





Route using wire slots and push excess into empty cavity. Ensure wires are free from screw boss and strain relief. Reinstall handle cover/handle tube onto handle assembly. Reassemble handle and cord dump with (5) Phillips screws



Connect vacuum to power and test for proper operation
